Please find attached our breakdown of Essential Education Items for the 2021 year. School Council made the commitment to keep Parent Payments the same in 2021 as they were this year and as such, it will remain at \$180 per student.

Each year Koo Wee Rup Primary School makes every effort to keep the number of items that students need to a minimum. We try to ensure that the costs are affordable for all parents therefore we order all items through an approved creditor to pass on the savings. 2021 Essential Items will arrive in individual stationery packs and handed to your child (in their classroom) once full payment has been received. The students will then have the benefit of using their own stationery throughout the school year.

Due to unforeseeable restrictions, all payments can only be made using our QKR Payment app.
***We cannot accept cash, Eftpos or Direct Deposit into our school account.**


